

## **CONTINUED SCHOOL BOARD MEETING**

Mr. Carl Jackson, Chairman, called the May 24, 2010, continued board meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Collins, the Board voted unanimously to go into executive session under Code 2.2-3711 (A)(1) Personnel and Code 2.2-3711 (A)(7) Consultation with Legal Counsel.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Collins, the Board voted unanimously to allow the school board attorney to advertise for the superintendent's position for 21 days; all applications must be post marked no later than 21 days after the vacancy is posted; the advertisement will be placed in the Bristol Herald Courier, The Lebanon News, the Coalfield Progress, and the Clinch Valley Times; those applications must be mailed to the school board attorney; and the advertisement and application will be posted on the school system web-site.

**Ms. Peggy Castle, RCEA President, expressed her concerns with the Board agreeing to pay the full retirement on new employees hired after July 1, 2010.**

**Mrs. Rebecca Dye presented the Board with the results of the State Department of Education's monitoring review of the Russell County School Nutrition Program.**

**Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Collins, the Board voted unanimously to move the next school board meeting to June 3, 2010, at 3:30 p.m. for executive session and 4:00 p.m. for the regular meeting.**
