

CONTINUED SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

Mr. Carl Jackson, Chairman, called the June 24, 2010, continued board meeting to order at 6:30 p.m.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Hillman, the Board unanimously approved the two year lease agreement with Leonard Companies Family Limited Partnership for the Alternative School in the amount of \$24,000.00.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to approve the attached resolution authorizing the Board to pick up the employee’s contribution of the VRS under Plan 2. (Attachment #1)

Upon motion made by Mr. Collins and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to approve the personnel list for 2010-2011. (Attachment #2)

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Hillman, the Board unanimously approved the following resignations:

Wayne Rasnick as the softball and boys' basketball coach at Castlewood High School, effective immediately; and

Kristy Sparks as the head varsity volleyball coach at Castlewood High School, effective immediately.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board voted unanimously to place Kathy Rhea on a 10 ½ month contract effective the 2010-2011 school year.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to approve the 2010-2011 Title 1 Application in the amount of \$1,473,749.27 and the 2010-2011 Consolidated Application in the amount of \$441,887.95.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Plaster and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board voted unanimously to amend the special covenants section of the bus driver contract to add "Driver will be required to sweep bus daily and wash as needed during the school year and at the end of the school year."

Mr. Carl Jackson informed the Board that he had received complaints from teachers saying that maintenance requests were not being completed. He asked Mr. Puckett to tell Principals to tell teachers to turn maintenance requests in at least twice before complaints are made. Teachers need to keep a copy of the requests. Principals need to submit requests and keep a copy of their requests.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to change the July meeting from July 1, 2010, to July 8, 2010, at 5:30 p.m. for executive session and 6:30 p.m. for regular session.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to continue the June 24, 2010, meeting to July 1, 2010, at 8:30 a.m.
