

CONTINUED SCHOOL BOARD MEETING

Mr. Carl Jackson, Chairman, called the September 16, 2010, continued board meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

Mr. David Cozzolino appeared before the Board to discuss the health insurance contract. Mountain States Health Alliance is dropping their contract with the USA/MCO group. This would make Russell County Medical Center out of the network or a Tier 3 group with higher deductibles and out of pocket expenses. The Health Insurance Committee recommends honoring the current contract that is in place with the Highlands Wellmont Health Network. Mr. Cozzolino informed the Board that we are currently in the second year of a three year contract with HWHN. At this point, it is unclear if all Mountain States Health Alliance facilities or just RCMC will be affected. After much discussion, no action was taken.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to approve the resignation of Phyllis Woods, part-time cafeteria worker at Castlewood Elementary/High School, effective immediately.

Mr. Puckett informed the Board that we currently have 41 non-English speaking students in the county this school year. We need two part-time positions to tutor and translate for the ELL students. Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board voted unanimously to advertise for two part-time tutors. The Education Jobs funding will be used to fund those positions. Mr. Puckett informed the Board that if the part-time positions could not be filled, we might have to consider hiring full-time individuals.

Mr. Puckett informed the Board that Russell County will receive \$1,114,082.00 from the Education Jobs funds.

Dr. Melton appeared before the Board in support of the Board adopting a contract with Mountain States Health Alliance.

The next meeting will be held on October 7, 2010, at 5:30 p.m. for executive session and 6:30 p.m. for regular session.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Plaster and seconded by Mrs. Cross, the Board voted unanimously to adjourn the September 16, 2010, continued meeting.
