

PUBLIC HEARING ON BUDGET

Mr. Charlie Collins, Chairman, opened the public hearing on the budget at 4:30 p.m.

Since no one was in the audience to address the Board concerning the budget, the Board asked the Central Office supervisors in attendance if they would like to address the Board regarding their budgets.

Mr. Larry Rasnake, Transportation Supervisor, asked the Board to purchase five new buses in the upcoming budget year. He also informed the Board that new cameras were needed on the buses.

Dr. Hess, Superintendent, asked the Board for assistant principals at Lebanon Elementary or Primary School and Swords Creek and Givens Elementary Schools. She also informed the Board that when the preliminary budget was sent to the Board of Supervisors, an additional \$512,000 was requested.

Mr. Jackson commented that additional resource officers were needed in the county.

Mr. Collins commented that an additional three physical education teachers were needed in the county because he had heard that there were schools that were only having p.e. two days a week. Dr. Hess said that to her knowledge, Honaker Elementary and Castlewood Elementary Schools were having p.e. every other day.

Mr. Rasnake also commented that new maintenance vehicles were needed.

Mr. Joey Long, Director of Maintenance, informed the Board that in the near future, the heating/cooling system at Lebanon High School would need to be addressed.

Mr. Collins closed the public hearing at 4:57 p.m.
