Upon motion made by Mrs. Plaster and seconded by Mrs. Cross, the Board unanimously adopted the attached resolution approving our 403(b) Plan Document. (Attachment #1)

Upon motion made by Mr. Jackson and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board voted unanimously to increase the 2009-2010 budget by \$48,000 to purchase a new bucket truck for the maintenance department.

Dr. Truman Atkins from Energy Education, Inc. discussed how his company would be able to help the county reduce it's energy consumption thereby saving money.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Jackson, the Board voted unanimously to raise the per diem for meals from \$25.00 to \$40.00.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board voted unanimously to approve the resignation of Margaret Davis, part-time cafeteria worker at Lebanon Elementary School, effective immediately.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board unanimously approved the following personnel:

appoint Elizabeth Sabo as a volunteer J. V. Girls Basketball Assistant at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season;

appoint Trevor Marchant as J. V. Girls Basketball coach at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season;

appoint Shannon Franklin as 8th grade girls basketball coach at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season;

appoint Karen Clay as girls basketball varsity assistant coach (to be paid by the school) at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season;

appoint Maurice Hayes as 8th grade boys basketball coach at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season;

appoint Jonathon Salyers as J. V. boys basketball coach at Castlewood High School for the 2008-2009 season; and

appoint Janet Stinson as a vocational driver for the 2008-2009 school year.

Upon motion made by Mrs. Cross and seconded by Mr. Griffith, the Board voted unanimously to uphold the 10 day suspension without pay of Employee A and the requirement of a letter to be sent from the recommended doctor certifying that he/she is able to return to work.

Upon motion made by Mr. Griffith and seconded by Mrs. Plaster, the Board unanimously approved the following:

uphold the suspension and recommendation that Student A from Lebanon High School go to the alternative homebound program;

uphold the suspension and recommendation that Student B from Lebanon High School go the Alternative School until Christmas;

uphold the suspension and recommendation that Student C from Castlewood High School go to the Alternative School for 45 days and that the situation be reviewed every 45 days in the event that student is not back at Castlewood;

uphold the suspension and recommendation that Student D from Castlewood High School go to the Alternative School until Christmas; and

uphold the suspension and recommendation that Student E from Lebanon Elementary School go the Alternative Middle School for two weeks.

Upon motion made by Mr. Jackson and seconded by Mrs. Cross, the Board unanimously approved the attached resolution regarding the traffic situation at Honaker Elementary School. (Attachment #2)
