



## Russell County Public Schools

### Prescription Medication

- Russell County Public Schools personnel may give prescription medication to students only with the written permission of the parent/guardian. Such permission shall include the name of the medication, the required dosage of the medication, and the time the medicine is to be given. Such medicine must be in the original container and delivered to the principal, school nurse or division designee by the parent/guardian of the student.
- When the medications are discontinued, the parents or guardians must pick up the medication from the school, not the student.
- When medication administration directions are changed a new form must be completed by the parents/guardian.
- Parents should collect medication the last day of school. Medication cannot be held at the school and will be destroyed.
